Anchorum Health Foundation Announces \$50,000 In Wildfire Relief Grants for Southern New Mexico

Santa Fe, NM — Anchorum Health Foundation is proud to announce \$50,000 in wildfire relief grants awarded to the Community Foundation of Southern New Mexico and the Mescalero Apache Tribe. These grants will support communities and residents in Lincoln County, Otero County, and the Mescalero Apache Tribe, which were affected by the South Fork Fire, Salt Fire, and flooding earlier this summer. The funds are intended to aid relief efforts in these impacted areas.

"Recovering from devastating fires goes beyond physical rebuilding," said Anchorum's Senior Vice President of Philanthropy, Jenny Parks. "It's about addressing the deep emotional and psychological scars left by displacement, ensuring our communities not only rebuild their homes, but also restore their sense of security and well-being."
