Santa Fe, NM — Anchorum Health Foundation is proud to sponsor award-winning journalist Margaret O'Hara to cover health issues for *The Santa Fe New Mexican*. As part of this arrangement, Anchorum will not have any role in editorial decisions, and the reporting will be freely available to all readers. Anchorum believes that important health news should reach every corner of the state, and efforts will be made to share this reporting with other New Mexico outlets.

Anchorum Health Foundation's grant comes at a time when *The Santa Fe New Mexican* has expanded its philanthropically supported efforts to fill journalism needs across the state. The New Mexican Public Service Journalism Fund – a philanthropic initiative established in December 2024 by *The Santa Fe New Mexican* – is fiscally sponsored by the New Mexico Foundation. The Fund is focused on informing and engaging the public through accountability journalism and storytelling for all New Mexicans.

New Mexican Executive Editor Bill Church said the Fund fills needs for: 1) New Mexico news outlets that may not have resource capabilities to do this level of data analyses and reporting on a regular basis; 2) trusted data-gathering and information dissemination made available for free for all New Mexicans; and 3) leveraged partnerships with key thought leaders to improve the quality of life in our state.
